I am excited to share another area where we can experience freedom- financial freedom for our church family. For the last eighteen years, we have included a monthly mortgage in our annual budget and God has faithfully provided. That mortgage includes a balloon payment which will be due in May 2023. We would like to retire this debt rather than take on another mortgage at that time.

To address this financial challenge, we are introducing the Released Initiative. Each aspect of this initiative is utterly focused on God's call for Journey Church to be Released, to symbolize not only escaping a monthly mortgage, but also to be Released to chase the vision that God has given us to Move People on a Simple Journey Toward Jesus. In the next few months, we will challenge our Journey Church family to prayerfully consider how each of us can participate in the Released Initiative. Our primary goal will be to eliminate the debt, but we will also share some ministry opportunities that we believe God is and will continue to lead us to as we are Released.

We will be inviting and challenging everyone, regardless of their level of support, to join us. We hope that you will decide to participate both in prayer and financially. Will you join us in this amazing next chapter of Journey Church's story?

"HUMBLE BEGINNINGS"

1966

A group from Bluegrass Christian Fellowship gathered to pray and seek God's direction for a church in Woodford County.

"GROWING MINISTRY"

1970s

The congregation moved into a new facility on Paddock Drive and hired the first full-time minister, Joe Bob Grider.

"EMBRACING THE FUTURE"

1980s

Facility expansion and land acquisition helped pave the path for greater ministry opportunities.

"DIVISION AND UNIFICATION"

<u> 1990s</u>

A season of turmoil was followed by unity among church members.

"RENEWING FAITH

1997

Randy Nation was hired as Senior Minister to help restore the divided churches into WCCC. "NEW LOCATION"

Plans for building a new ministry center began and ground was broken in October 2001. "Building on the Rock" stewardship campaign began.

2003

May 4th was opening day at our facility. Church members walked the Cross from the old building to the new building, in an expression of faithfulness.

Now - Dedicated ministry continues through missions, Journey Preschool, Journey Hoops, Journey Camp, Celebrate Recovery, and many more to help move people on a simple journey toward lesus.





WHAT IS THE RELEASED INITIATIVE?

Released is a generosity initiative designed specifically to unify our financial stewardship program into One Fund that includes our annual ministry budget, debt reduction, and future ministry opportunities. This initiative enables Journey Church to set our vision and financial goals for the 18-month period of December 2021 through May 2023.

The goal for our Released Initiative over the next 18 months is \$2.5 million which will enable us to live out our mission and vision with greater effectiveness, impact our community and advance the Kingdom by moving people on a simple journey toward Jesus.

Create more possibilities for the future through debt freedom.

This One Fund strategy will help us to stay focused on the entire mission that God has given us.



God has been generous to us.

Moses told the people of Israel a truth that continues to this very day:

"He will love you and bless you and increase your numbers. He will bless the fruit of your womb, the crops of your land – your grain, new wine and oil – the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks in the land that he swore to your forefathers to give you. You will be blessed more than any other people..." Deuteronomy 7:13-14a

We practice generosity because God has generously blessed us in every way. Our generous giving is a response to God's outrageous goodness.

We give generously to be a blessing to others.

The Apostle Paul reminds us of this certain truth:

"In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive."" Acts 20:35

We practice generosity in order to share the blessings of God with those who are in need of every kind. Our generous giving provides spiritual guidance, food, shelter, medicine, clothing, comfort and hope to those in need.

We practice generosity to share God's kingdom of love.

Jesus himself told us:

"Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life ... But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well" Matthew 6:25a, 33

Our generous gifts empower our ministry of sharing the good news of God's love for all people as we work for justice, righteousness and peace.

We give generously to discover true and lasting joy.

The Apostle Paul shares this life-changing insight:

"Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each one of you should give as you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." 2 Corinthians. 9:6-7

When we learn the lessons of generosity and practice them in our lives, we discover new joy and cheerfulness. Generosity brings joy!

HOW MUCH SHOULD I COMMIT?

The decision of how much to commit to the Released Initiative is a personal one. No one can make that decision for you. As you approach the decision, we encourage you to:

Listen To God

Prayerfully seek God's guidance as you make your commitment decision.

Evaluate Your Resources

Truly consider everything God has put under your stewardship.

Nail Down the Specifics

Determine specifically how your resources can become a generous gift.

Educate Yourself

Consider out-of-the-box ways that you can increase your gift.

Walk By Faith

Determine your best commitment and trust God to help you successfully fulfill it.

Extravagant

I give beyond my tithe to God through Journey Church and will continue to look for more opportunities to practice generosity.

Tithing

I faithfully give 10% of my income to God through Journey Church, but I sense God calling me to do more.

Intentional

I consistently give to God through Journey Church, but I want to accept the challenge to become a tither.

Occasional

I give to God through Journey Church, but I could be more consistent.

First Time

I have not yet given to God through Journey Church, but I want to take this step.

WHAT CHANGES CAN I MAKE?



Practice Priority Budgeting

Many families may choose to rearrange their financial priorities. By identifying unnecessary or less important expenses that are currently in the budget, you can free up funds that become part of the Released Initiative commitment.



Redirect Present Expenditures

Some families have short-term expenditures or loans that will soon be settled. Once these expenses are paid off, the funds, which are already a part of your budget, can be redirected to the Released Initiative.



Increase Giving with Increased Income

Sometimes a family may be aware of an expected bonus or an upcoming increase in income. You could choose to plan on including these increases in income in your total commitment.



Donate Assets



Some families may have stocks, bonds or other securities that have appreciated in value. These assets can be included in your commitment. There are potential tax advantages to this type of transaction, but there are also potential penalties. Therefore, before making a contribution of this type, we encourage you to consult your CPA, tax attorney or financial advisor.



Give in person

You can give during worship services each week during the offering time.

Give online

HOW DO I DETERMINE HOW MUCH TO GIVE?

Many often ask, "What am I expected to give?" Since a major funding initiative is new to many - if not most - people, it's a great question. Let's start at the beginning:

- As you learn more and more about the Released Initiative, continue to ask God how He can use you through the mission of Journey Church. As you pray, read and search the Bible, have faith that God will stir your heart to determine what your gift will be.
- Take a good look at what you give annually to the church, then determine what gifts "over and above" that amount you might give over a 18-month period.

That's what the Released Initiative is all about, diving deeper into the calling that God has for Journey Church.

What Is The Released Initiative?

The Released Initiative is our ministry focus for the next 18 months, acknowledging we must trust God to provide the direction and financial resources needed for being effective in our ministry. It is of vital importance to work toward eliminating our debt (money owed on our facility) and funding the other 4 key areas of our vision.

What Are You Asking Me To Do?

First and foremost, we are asking that you pray and seek God's leading on what He is asking of you. Prepare your heart to hear Him, and then follow what He says. Engage in a Journey Group during this season, if you haven't already. Talk with your spouse and your family about what this commitment will mean for this next exciting season of our lives.

We are asking that you make a sacrificial commitment to The Released Initiative – whatever it is that God leads you to do. Follow His leading – nothing more, nothing less. Finally, we ask that you prepare to be amazed. We serve an awesome God, and He is going to show up in big ways! We anticipate a huge impact from our collective Released commitments. Engage with the worship and community opportunities that will be remembered as a defining moment in our church and faith.



What is a One Fund?

You may have been part of church campaigns in the past during which you were invited to give a second gift over and above your usual gift to make special initiatives like new buildings and new ministries possible. There was a "General Fund" for ongoing ministries, and a separate "Building Fund" or "Campaign Fund" for capital projects and certain other ministries. While this approach has served churches well, we also recognize the potential for confusion. It required an explanation to make clear which fund did what and not everyone participated. It is time for a change.

Released is a new, simpler way. From now on, everything we do is part of One Fund. Everyone can get involved and participate. It makes sense because we are all on one mission: to move people on a simple journey toward Jesus. Our Released Initiative will last 18 months as we work together to make an impact. In those 18 months, every gift that is given to Journey Church will go into the One Fund. Then after Released is over, we will continue giving to the One Fund as we continue to expand the mission of God here at Journey Church and beyond.
